Students who wish to pursue K-3 Licensure and teach in Utah must apply to the UITE and complete section (2.) K-3 Pre-licensure Courses **and** section (3.) Licensure Program Courses. Students who successfully complete sections 1,2,3 and pass the necessary examinations and related criteria will be licensed to teach kindergarten through third grade in Utah schools.

We recommend that students who begin the combined program as first year students should formally apply during their second year of course work. Students who begin the program later in their college career should meet with an academic advisor to determine the best time to apply for the licensure component.

Application requirements for K-3**Licensure cohort:**

- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Pass the ECE Praxis II exam (5025) or Elementary Education: Multiple Subjects Praxis II (5001)
- Three letters of recommendation
- Background check
- Personal statement
